

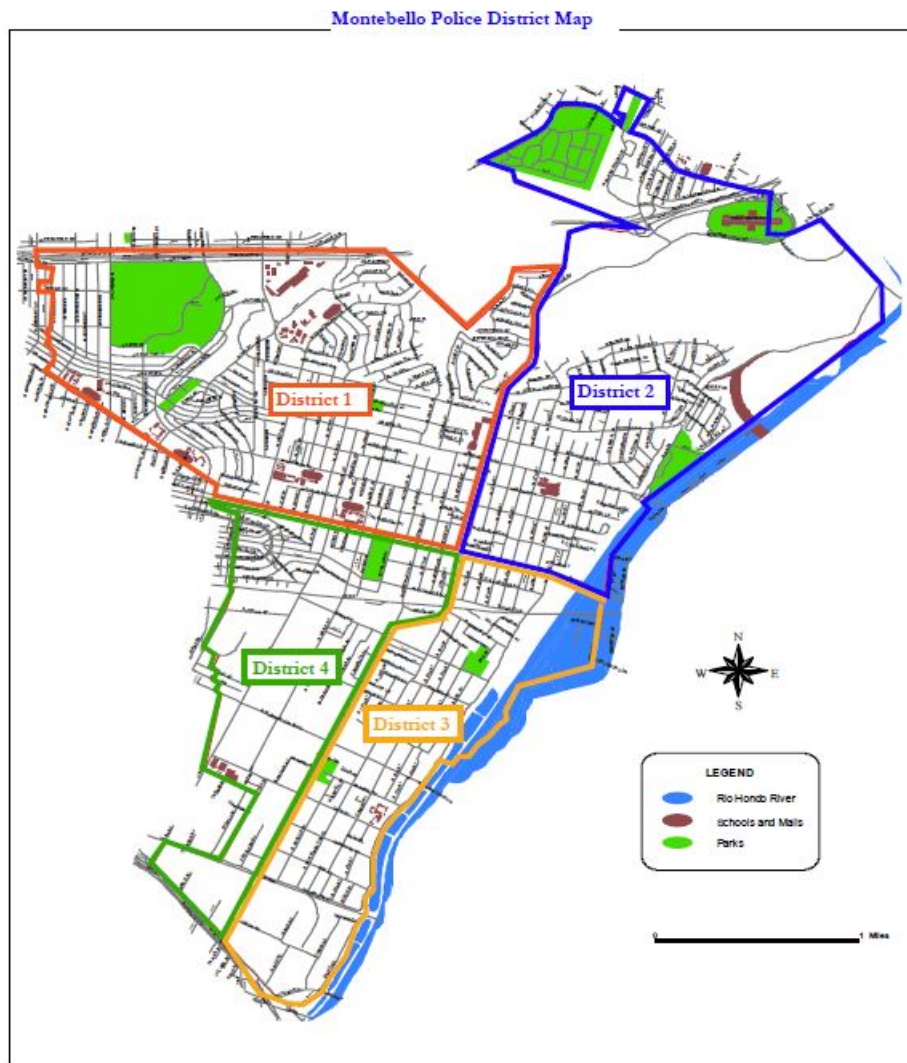
## District Policing

In order to best serve our community, the Montebello Police Department divides the city into four districts: 1, 2, 3, and 4, based on where you live or work in the city, you have representatives assigned to assist you. As an example, if you are experiencing long-term problems in your neighborhood, your District Commander can assist in working with you to remedy the issue.

The District Policing model supports the vision for developing a continuous improvement focus based policing culture in Montebello. Focus Based Policing is a distinct management philosophy recognizing the need for continuous performance improvement through employee development and a never ending acceptance of the status quo. Each team member evaluates their assigned duties with an approach of looking for ways we can add value to our service and improve our operations.

Situations requiring an immediate police response should be reported via 911 for emergencies and (323) 887-1313 – for non-emergent response.
